SMOKING POLICY

The **Chelsea Bowling Club** recognises that passive smoking is hazardous to health and those non-smoking club members and visitors who have the right to be protected from exposure to tobacco smoke.

Accordingly, the following policy shall apply to all club facilities, events, functions, meetings and activities undertaken by the club and will apply to all members, officials, players and club visitors.

Smoking is defined as having a lit cigarette, pipe, cigar, electronic nicotine delivery system (ends/vaping) including e-cigarettes and any other form of smoking device.

Non-compliance

All club committee members will enforce the smoke free policy and any non-compliance will be handled according to the following process:

- Explanation of the club policy to the person/people concerned, including identification of the areas in which smoking is permitted
- Continued non-compliance with the policy should be handled by at least two committee members who will use their discretion as to the action taken, which may include asking the person/ people to leave the club facilities or function.

Policy Promotion

The club will promote the smoke free policy regularly by:

- Putting a copy of the policy in club newsletters, notice boards,
- Displaying signs outside the clubrooms

Policy Review

This policy will be reviewed as required to ensure it remains relevant to club operations and reflects both community expectations and legal requirements.
