CLUB ATTIRE POLICY

The Chelsea Bowling Club welcomes neat, casual clothes.

Whilst at our Club gentlemen are asked to wear attire that covers their shoulders and appearance must be clean, neat, tidy and respectful at all times.

Whilst at our Club ladies are asked that appearance is clean, neat, tidy and respectful at all times.

We ask that the following clothing is not worn at our club at any time:

- Soiled or dirty
- Damaged
- Offensively logoed
- Excessively revealing or intimidating

Work clothing may be worn; however, dirty, torn or offensive clothing is not permitted.

Hats, caps or beanies are not to be worn in the clubrooms (Excludes Lady Pennant bowlers and/or as required for medical, religious or other sporting occasions).

Footwear must have flat rubber heel less soles & may be worn without socks, but thongs are not permitted (excluding the "OOFOS Original Thong" which is permitted by Bowls Australia under their approved footwear - specifically by make/model).

When playing Pennant

Members must wear the club's registered shirt, royal blue trousers, shorts, dresses, culottes, skorts, skirts, slack suits, skirt suits or pedal pushers and if a jacket is required, we expect members to wear the club jacket.

Headwear is always optional; however, it is recommended that all members protect themselves from the elements at all times. At Chelsea we expect hats/headwear to be white or royal blue in colour and must have the Bowls Australia Logo. White block hats with club hatband may be worn (no BA logo required).

The Board of Management's decision shall be final in all matters relating to dress and behaviour.

This policy will be reviewed as required
